The Third Relief Work to Kachin Refugees October 14th

Dear brothers and sisters,

By the grace of God, the third relief work was successfully done among the refugees in Kachin state. The cease-fire agreement was not signed by the Kachin rebel and the battle continues in Kachin state. I flew to Myitkyina on October 6th and arrived there at 10:00 am. At this time by myself from Yangon since we have Isaiah Fish and Di Di in Myitkyina. At 12:00 noon on the same day, we purchased 100 bags of rice in Myitkyina. At 2:00 pm, we held a fellowship meeting with representatives of the refugee families from Sum Bram Bon, a town located northern Kachin state and gave words of encouragement to them from the Bible. After the meeting, we distributed the rice bags to 36 families based on the number of the family members. We distributed 4 bags to families of 7-9 members, 3 bags to 5-6 and 2 bags to 3-4 family members.

The next morning, Isaiah, Di Di and I left for Tanai (the MACM mission field) and arrived there at 1:00 pm. We were met by the local church leaders. At 2:30 pm, we purchased another 100 bags of rice in Tanai and transported them to the village where the refugees from Par Kant settled in. Here the distribution of the rice bags was different from the previous one. The church elders asked us to leave all the rice bags at the church storeroom. They explained to us that they usually distribute the rice to each family once a week based on the number of the family members. We trust the elders and the pastor and left the 100 bags to the church storeroom. We spent the night at the village. The fellowship meeting was held at 7:00 pm and I encouraged them from the word of God. I also told the congregation a little bit about how American Christian brothers and sisters extended their love to them in Christ. They are always amazed at the greatness of God's love, extended to them from this far places. Dear brothers and sisters, thanks a lot for allowing us to bring such impact on the lives of the people with the love of Christ expressed by you. Thank you so much. We love you.
